In Ukraine, studies for elderly people usually take form of vocational clubs of interests where people learn from each other. The motivators for such clubs are considerable quantities of free time, absence of numerous close relatives, active living position and the desire to unite into small groups and well as the desire to acquire new interesting knowledge and learn new skills. The clubs usually unite intelligent elderly people in small cities all over Ukraine. They usually learn handicraft, choir singing, some popular group sports games, and group dancing including folk dance. The activity of such clubs is supported by local self-governance through donation and organizational support, including organization of festivals for such clubs.
