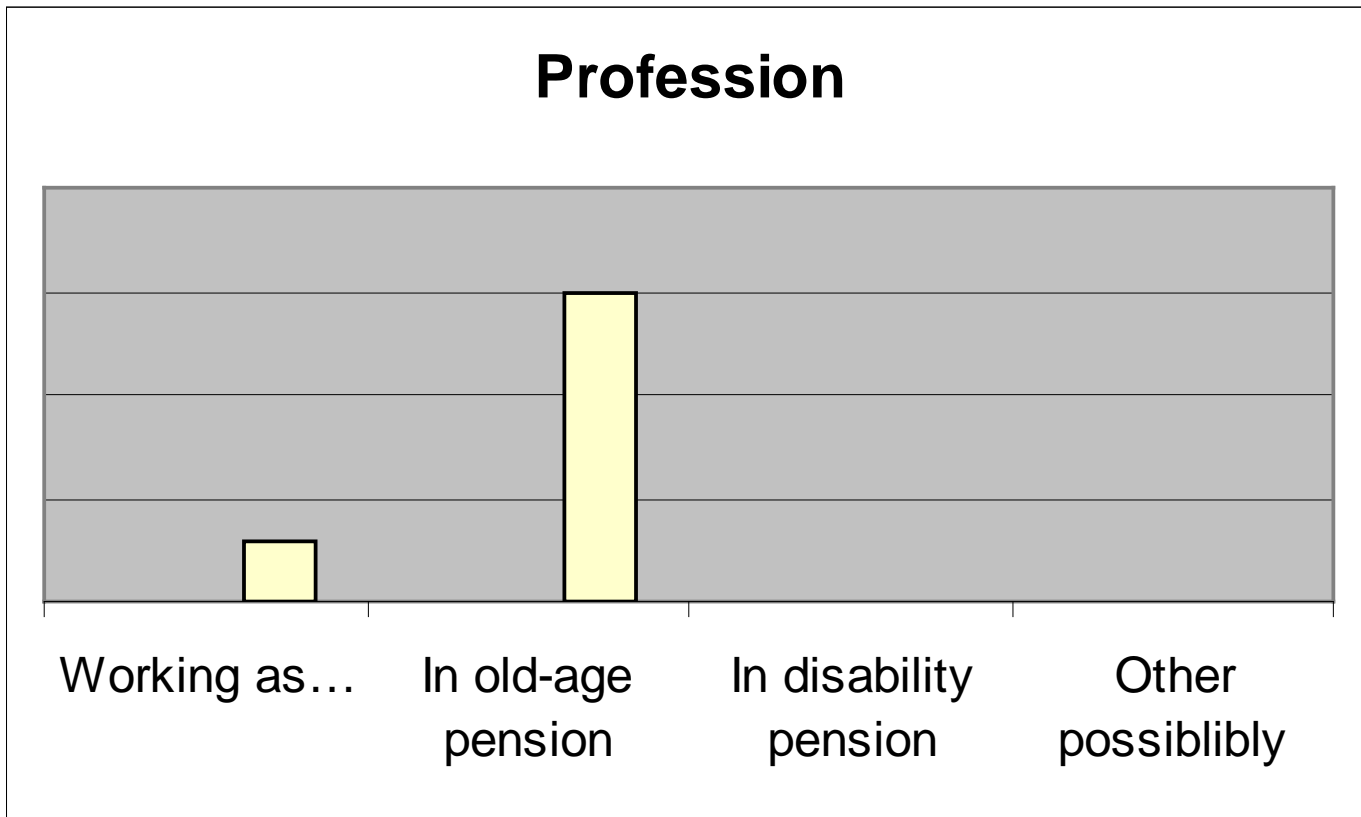

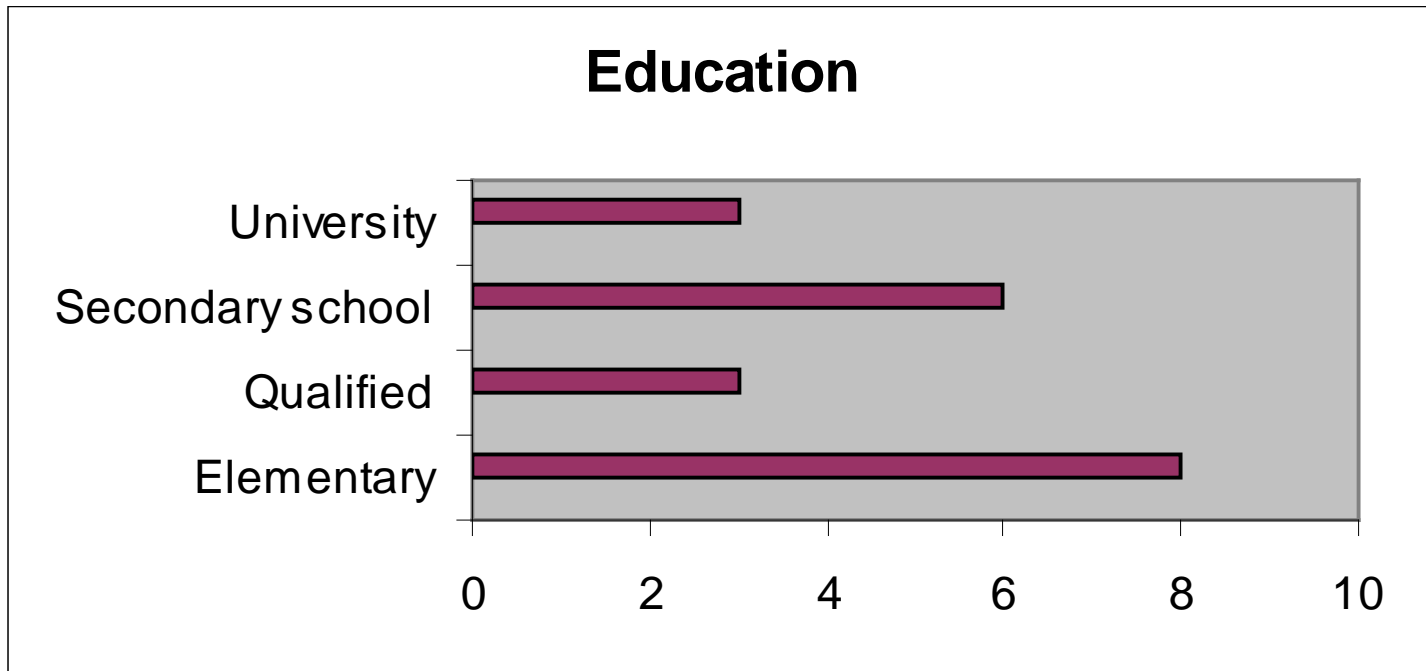

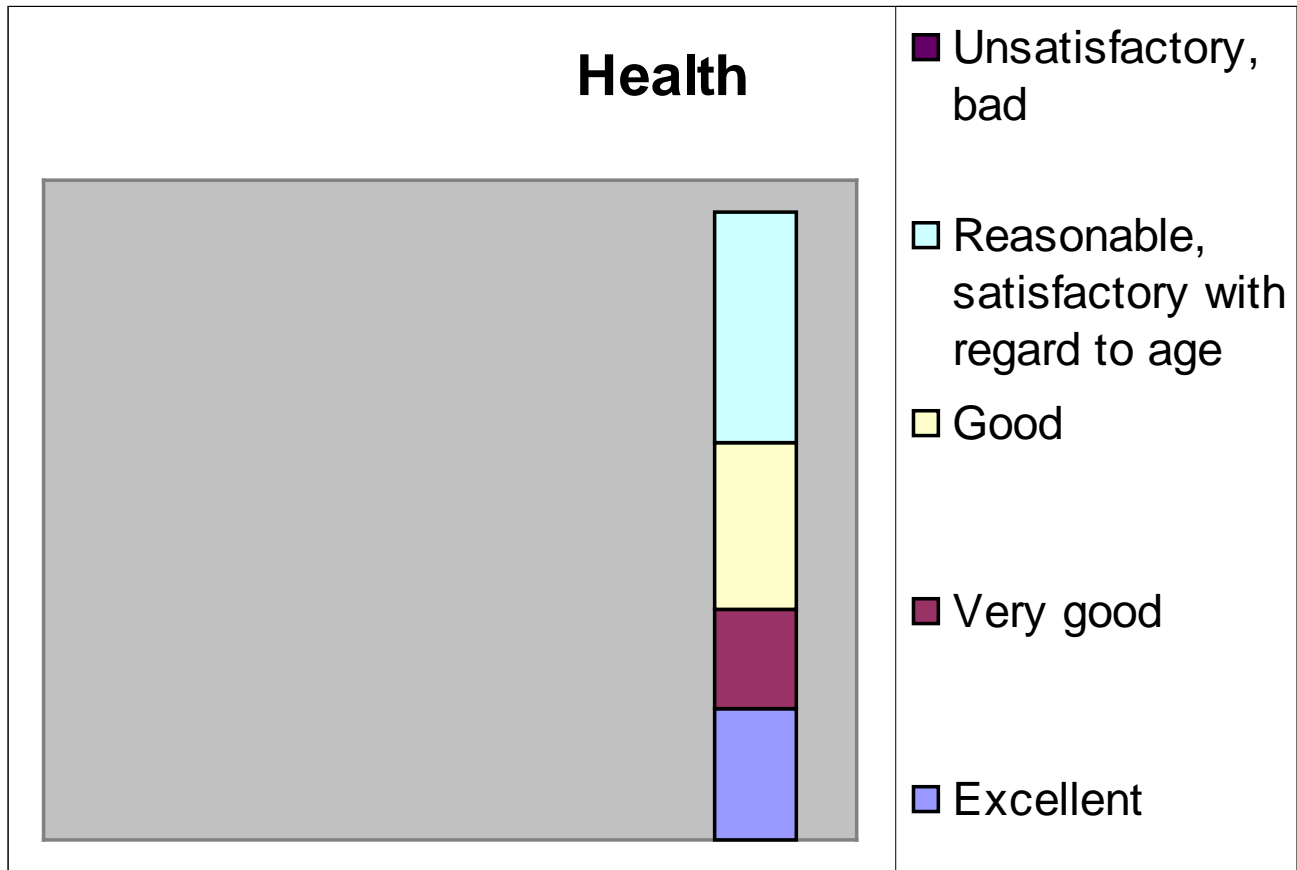
... in old - age pension

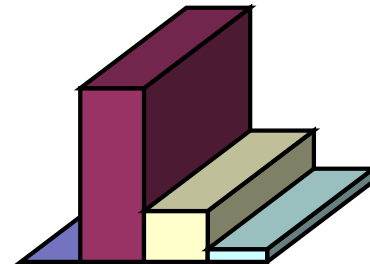

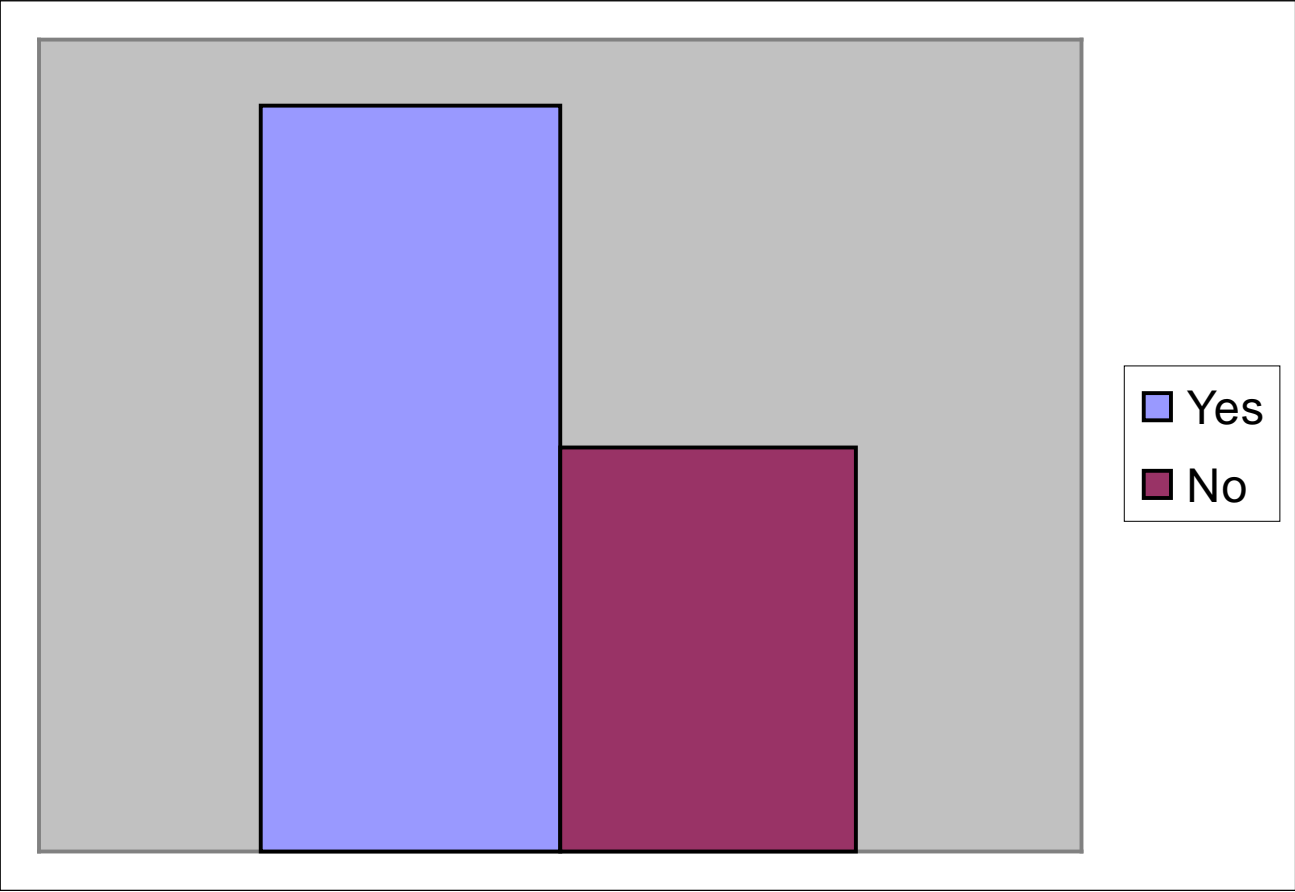

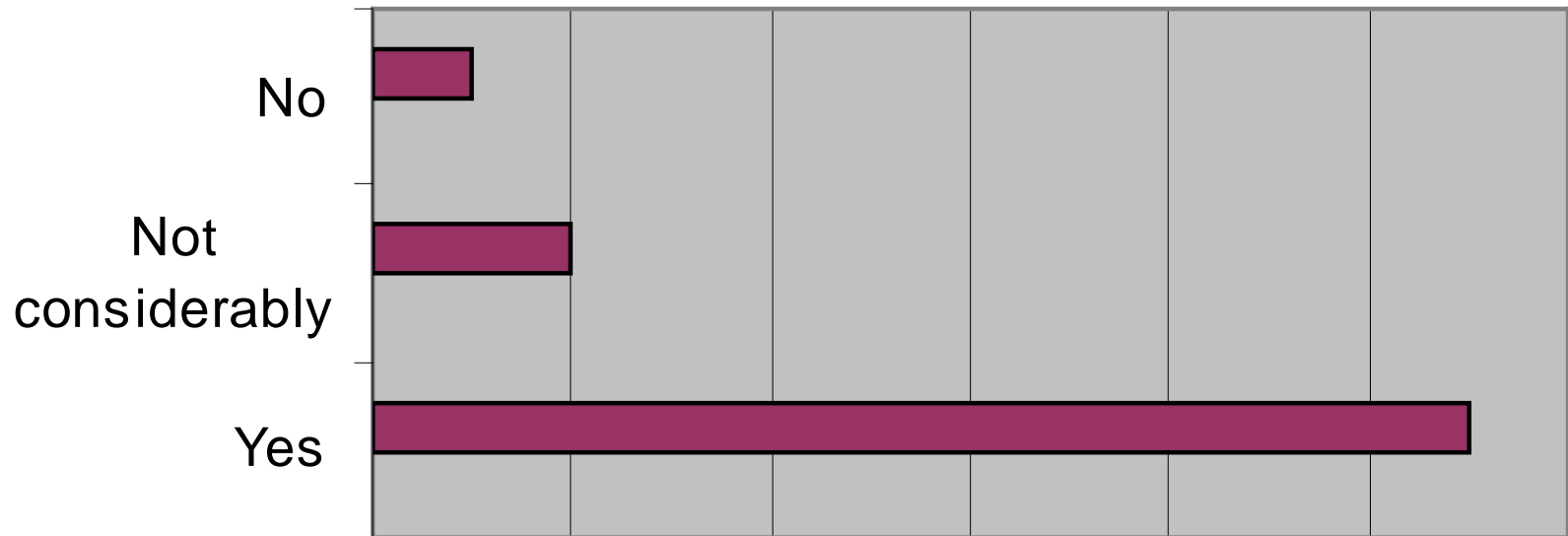


Did women have conditions (time and means) to implement their idea of their future profession?

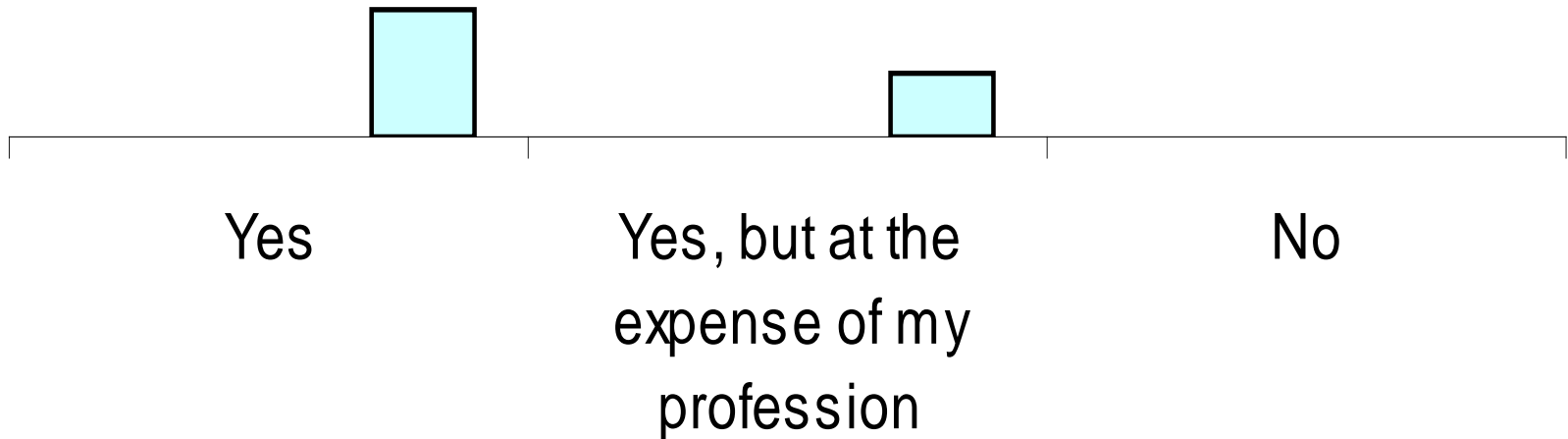

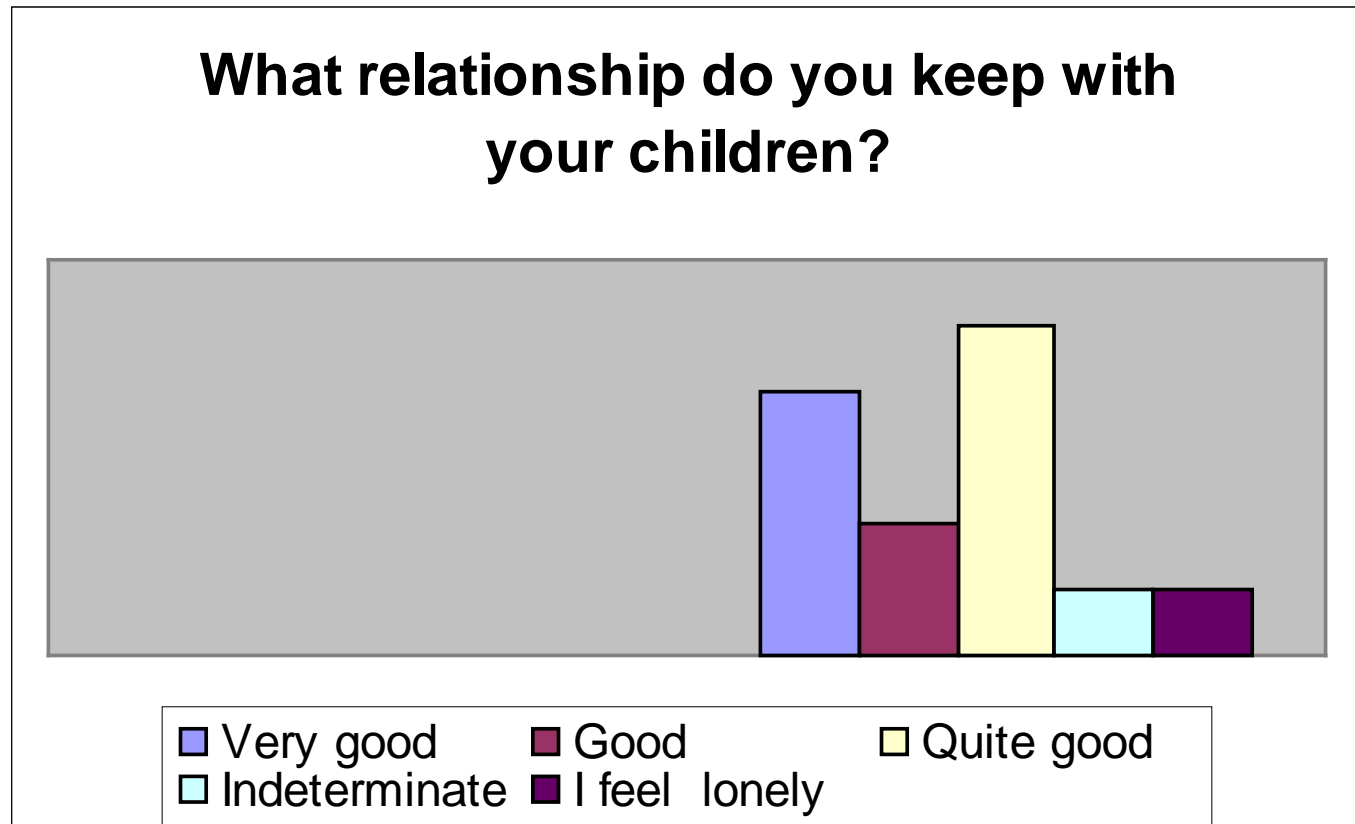
Did your life change when you married?



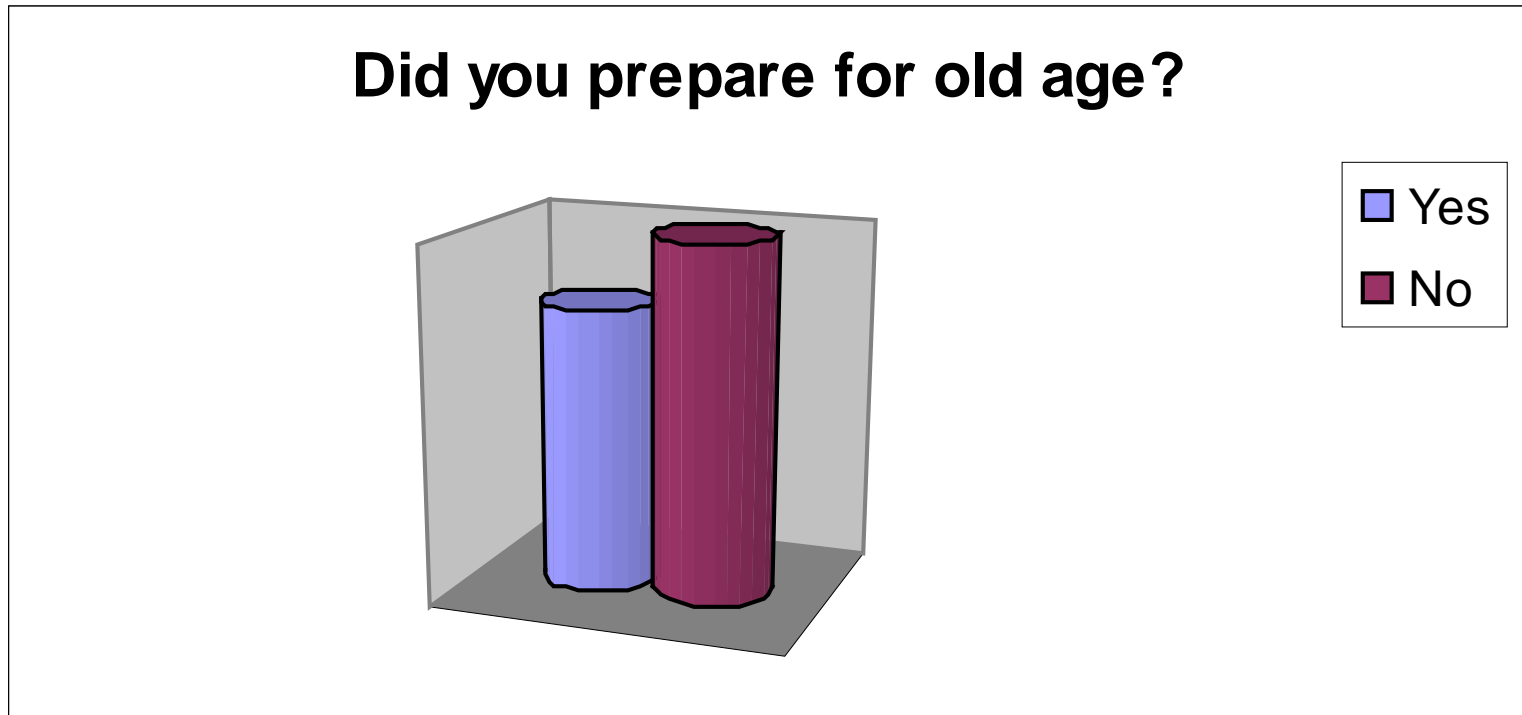

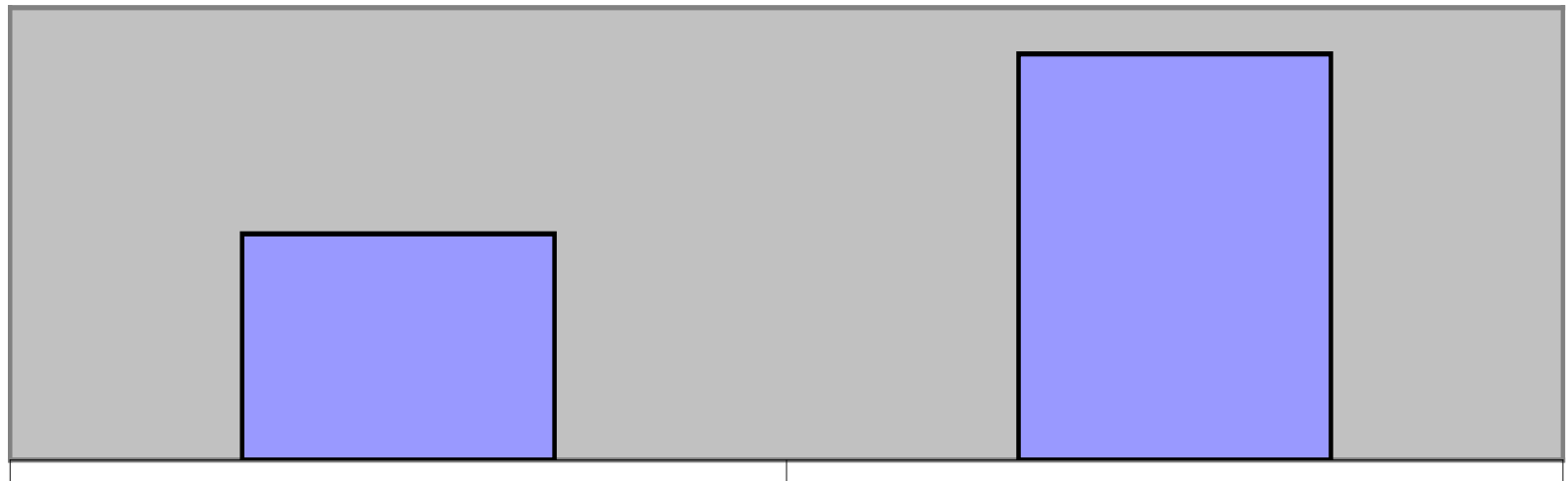

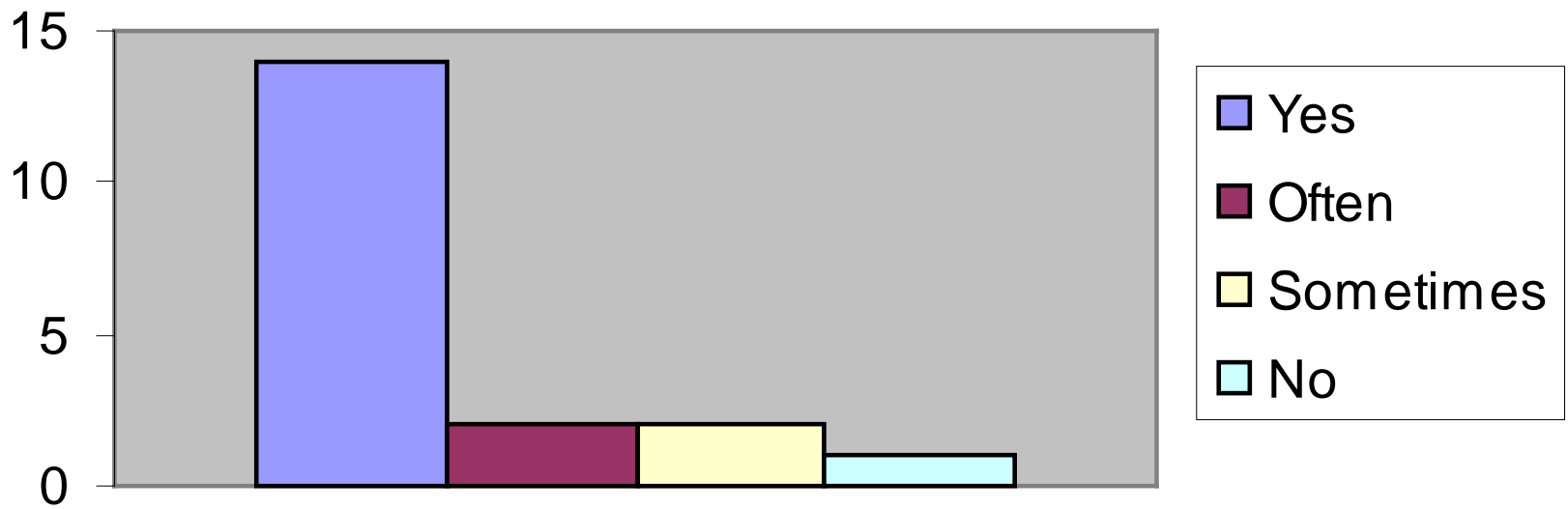

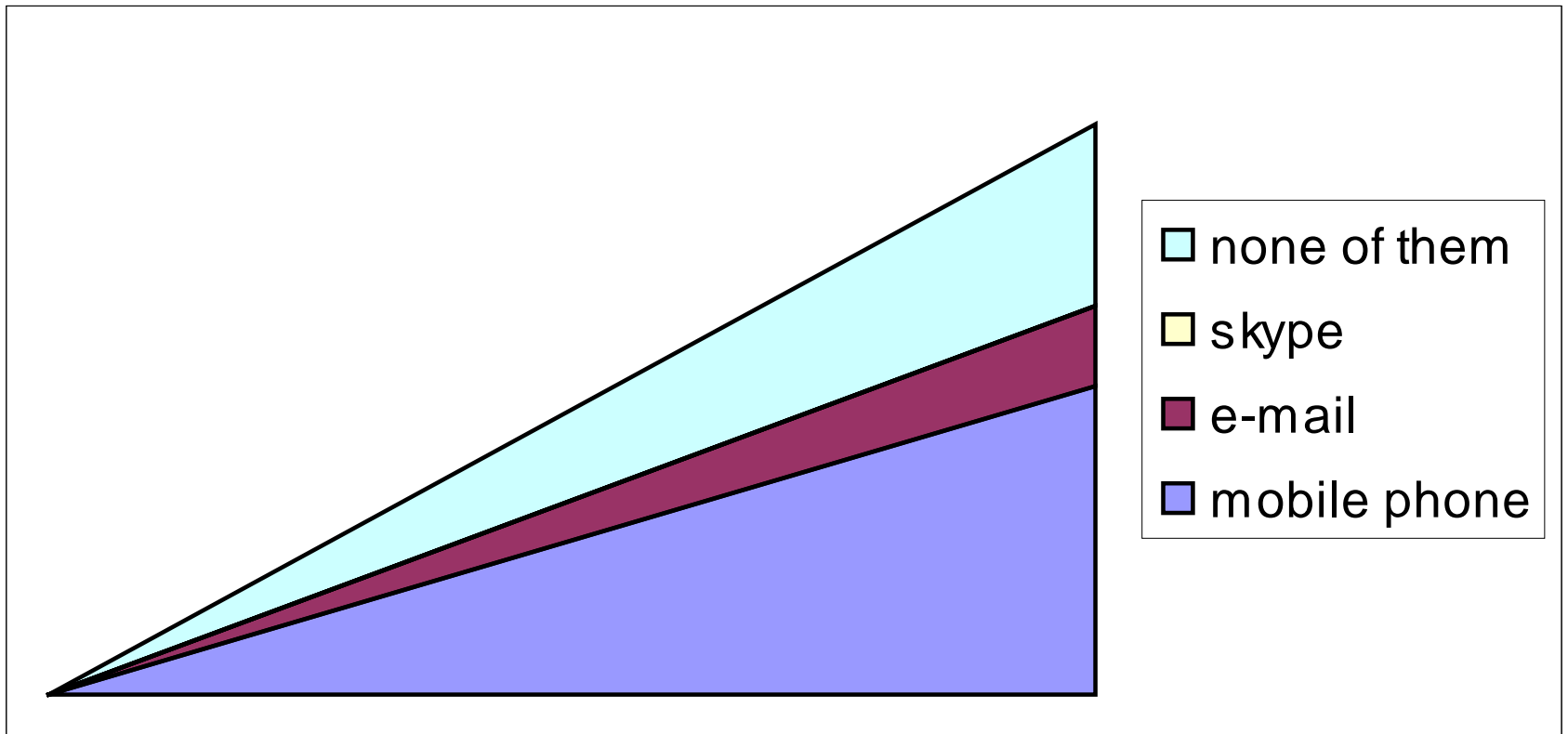
